

Welcome to the Bulkley Valley Rod and Gun Club Trap Range

We want everyone to have a fun and safe shooting experience at our club so please ensure you read and adhere to the following rules.

Firearm discharge is allowed from 9:00am to 9:00pm

In winter, discharge is allowed in DAYLIGHT HOURS within that timeframe

1. Range use is restricted to members and their guests who have paid the 5.00 user fee and signed the ledger inside the rifle shooting shed.
2. It is every person's (shooter or not) responsibility to ensure maximum safety and to handle firearms with that in mind at all times.
3. It is every user's responsibility to read and adhere to the posted rules.
4. Alcohol and/or drugs, or using firearms under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs, is strictly forbidden.
5. **CHECK YOUR AMMUNITION!** This is a trap range only and only trap loads are permitted. Ammo within 7.5 – 9 and lead shot only. Nothing larger (7.5 and under) and no steel shot or game loads permitted. Maximum Barrel size is 12 Gauge.
6. **ONLY CLAY DISC TARGETS** are permitted on the trap range, nothing else. No bottles, glass, plastic, electronic equipment etc. Exploding reactive targets are not permitted.
7. Personal clay throwers are to be set up in between the trap houses to avoid broken clays from littering the shooting pads.
8. Hearing and eye protection is required for all shotgunners.
9. Spectators not allowed on the trap range while shooting is in progress and hearing protection is strongly recommended.
10. The Range Officer and/or Squad Referees are responsible for the safe and efficient operation of the range. Their directions are to be followed at all times.
11. Shotgun actions are to be open at all times except when the shooter is standing on a shooting pad or when placing an over/under, side/side or other fixed breech gun in the vertical gun racks.
12. Firearms are to be carried between stations open, unloaded and in a safe direction at all times until ready to shoot.
13. Whenever a Cease Fire is called all shooters will immediately stop shooting, unload and make their firearms safe.
14. After a misfire or hang-fire, the action must remain closed for a full 60 seconds with the muzzle pointed down range in a safe direction. The muzzle must stay pointed in a safe direction until the firearm can be cleared.
15. Do not distract other shooters by picking up used hulls during shooting.
16. If a yellow flag is posted above the trap, all guns must be unloaded and kept in a safe direction.
17. **CLEAN UP AFTER YOURSELF!!** Used hulls should go in the appropriate container.
18. All unbroken targets on the ground are the property of the Club. Further use of these targets is left to the discretion of the Trap or Sporting event Chairman.

The Bulkley Valley Rod and Gun Club reserves the right to refuse use of the range or have removed, any person whether a member or not, who is in contravention of these rules or behaves in a way that jeopardizes the safety or enjoyment of this facility by other users.
